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STAGE 1: CLASSIFICATION

Extremists **divide** people into **separate groups** based on their different characteristics. They create an **us-vs-them mentality**, searching for someone to blame for social problems.

STAGE 2: SYMBOLIZATION

The dominant group assigns **symbols** or **names** to members of the other group. The goal is to split the society and make it clear **who** belongs to which group.

STAGE 3: DISCRIMINATION

The dominant group uses its power to deny others certain **rights** or **privileges**. New laws may **limit the freedom** of the marginalized. Instances of bullying increase and the **societal divide** widens.

STAGE 8: PERSECUTION

Violence escalates. The targeted group is systematically subjected to **harassment, displacement**, and/or other forms of **abuse**. This often happens under the excuse of "security measures."

STAGE 9: EXTERMINATION

Mass killing begins. The culprits view their victims as **less than human** and believe they are "cleansing" the world of an undesirable element. They justify the use of **disproportionate violence**.

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STAGE 5: ORGANIZATION

This stage can involve **violent mobs** that are tolerated by the ruling class, and/or the creation of state-sponsored militias. In some instances, perpetrators now carefully start to **plan the next steps** of the genocide.

STAGE 7: PREPARATION

Leaders now **plan for mass murder**. They may identify victims by name or number, find where they live and **acquire weapons** or build facilities to aid their efforts.

STAGE 4: DEHUMANIZATION

The targeted group is portrayed as **less than human**, often compared to **animals or diseases**. Diminishing people's human qualities makes it easier to justify **violence** against them.

STAGE 6: POLARIZATION

Extremists **demonize** the targeted group and try to fully divide society, demanding that everyone must **take a side**. Moderators who try to reduce tensions are often identified as enemies and **silenced**.

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STAGE 1: DENIAL

Those responsible for the cruelty **deny their crimes**, destroy evidence, blame the victims, and attempt to rewrite history to justify their actions as necessary for the greater good.

When people are **suffering**, they try to find reasons for their troubles. In times of **unrest and insecurity**, political extremists can **rise to power** as they **blame certain groups** of people, promising that getting rid of these groups will cure society's problems.

The **10 Stages of Genocide** are a framework for understanding how **crimes against humanity** happen so we can **spot early warning signs** and potentially prevent them. These stages may not be linear, and sometimes occur at the same time.

Dr. Gregory Stanton suggested preventative measures to battle each stage. However, he believed that ultimately **only an international intervention** can stop such a disaster.

AFTERMATH AND ACCOUNTABILITY

After a genocide, **criminals** must be held accountable and **trauma** must be addressed. Then the survivors may heal and society can **attempt to reunite**.

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
